Persons coming across an accident should call a first aider if available

Please observe the following guidelines:

❖ Observe the area to make sure its safe

- ❖ Call emergency services if necessary
- ❖ Ask the person what happened
- ❖ Give the necessary first aid
 - e.g.
 - If bleeding apply pressure
 - If not breathing,
 - call ambulance 112 / 999
 - commence CPR
 - call for nearest AED to be brought

Give address of where casualty is now

An accident report should be filled in completely for all accidents and near misses, (this can be found in the club house on the wall, and in the first aid kit.)

First aid kit can be found in the club on the wall.

All accidents should be reported on to a club committee person as early as possible, (contact number at the top of page).

If any areas or equipment that requires attention or might be seen as a risk to cause a potential accident, place a notice to make others aware of the immediate danger and bring it to the attention of a committee member asap
